12949: Declaration of Pecuniary: None received.

12950: To approve the minutes of meetings:

12951: Reports from Councillors:

Ward Councillor Ian Arnold delivered his update:

Tony Matthias resigned as Council leader and also as Ward councillor. Oliver Helmsley will stand in for the time being.

Biffa undertook mechanical moss clearing at Hall Close, Foxhill and Sherrards Close locations. The result is good but more work is required.

lan is still chasing the replacement post box with Royal Mail. The complaint was first raised on 11th September. lan will now write to the C.E.O.

lan has been working with the shop for a resolution on the parking issue and achieved some progress with a loading bay request restricting parking between 8am and 6pm.

A request for road repairs previously reported, such as the bus stop area and the raised manhole, ironwork on Melton Road/Thorpe Gardens junction, the "finger post" at the bottom of Melton Road – this was asked to be repaired, not replaced. A footpath sign that is lying on the ground by a gateway on Station Road should be done shortly and the "kissing gates" installed by end of February.

A discussion was held regarding the state of the Three Horseshoes public house as many residents have commented on the poor image for the Village.

A discussion took place regarding the Grit Bins and a request was put forward to ascertain the cost of RCC supplying more bins to the Village.
