(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE)
Whissendine Road
Parish of Ashwell CP Order 2020**

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Diversion of Vehicular Traffic) Whissendine Road Parish of Ashwell CP Order 2020 as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

The effect of the order will be that during the dates and times specified below all vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the length of road known as Whissendine Road from Teigh Road to Ashwell Road

The closure is to enable Network Rail to undertake work on the drainage system.

The duration of the Closure shall be for a maximum period of six months from 20th July 2020 or until the works are completed.

It is anticipated the works will take 4 nights. The closure shall come into force when the appropriate signs and diversion route are erected on site.

The duration of the Closure shall be as follows: from 22:00 on 20th July 2020 to 06:00 on 21st July 2020, from 22:00 on 21st July to 06:00 on 22nd July 2020, from 22:00 on 22nd July 2020 to 06:00 on 23rd July and from 22:00 on 23rd July 2020 to 06:00 on 24th July 2020

The alternative route during the closure will be via the route shown on the attached plan (also available to view at the Council Office) and as shown on <https://one.network>

The alternative route during the closure will be via the following streets: Oakham Road, Ashwell Road, Langham Lane, Burley Road, Melton Road, Whissendine Lane, Main Street and Ashwell Road with a reciprocal route.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
