

## RUTLAND COUNTY COUNCIL DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION NOTICE) Mount Pleasant Hill Parish of Whissendine Order 2022

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Restriction of Vehicular Traffic) Mount Pleasant Hill Parish of Whissendine Order 2022 as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

The effect of the order will be that during the dates and times specified below all vehicles will be subject to a temporary speed limit of not more than 10mph under convoy working along the length of road known as Mount Pleasant Hill from the junction with Pickwell Lane to the junction with Stygate Lane

The restriction is to enable Tarmac to undertake patching works on behalf of Rutland County Council.

The duration of the Restriction shall be for a maximum period of six months from 17th January 2022 or until the works are completed.

It is anticipated the works will take 2 days. The restriction shall come into force when the appropriate signs and vehicles are present on site.

The duration of the Restriction shall be as follows: from 17th January 2022 to 18th January 2022

The route of the restriction is shown on the attached plan and as shown on https://one.network

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
