## Whissendine 6ix Parish of Whissendine CP Order 2022

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 16A(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Diversion of Vehicular Traffic) Whissendine 6ix Parish of Whissendine CP Order 2022 as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because the Whissendine 6ix Road Race Event is being held on or near the road.

The effect of the order will be that during the dates and times specified below all vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the length of roads known as:

- Melton Road from Walton Close to Oakham Road
- Oakham Road from Melton Road to Stapleford Road
- Main Street from Oakham Road junction to Ashwell Road
- Stapleford Road from Oakham Road to the county boundary with Leicestershire
- Whissendine Road from the county boundary with Rutland to the junction with Holygate Road
- Holygate Road from Whissendine Road to Station Road at the county boundary with Rutland
- Station Road from the county boundary with Leicestershire to Main Street

The duration of the Closure shall be as follows from 19:25 to 20:35 on 8th July 2022

The closure will be under a rolling road closure with each section being closed as the runners make their way round the course.

The route of the closure is shown on the attached plan and as shown on https://one.network

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
