What is courier fraud?

It's a scam where criminals pretend to be the police or the victim's bank, tricking victims into providing banking details including cards, withdrawing cash, foreign currency or purchasing gold, watches or other expensive items.

These items are handed over to strangers (known as couriers) who are posing as police or bank workers who come and collect these items from the victim.

What are the impacts?

Around 60% of victims are over 70, with an average loss of around £5,000 per victim.

To the people targeted by courier fraud criminals, it's devastating financially and emotionally.

Over £15 million was stolen in 2021. For the crime gangs profiting, that money goes towards funding other crimes in the community.
