**(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE)**

**Order**

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 16A (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Diversion of Vehicular Traffic) Order 2022 as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because the Whissendine 6ix Road Race is proposed to be held on or near the roads.

The effect of the order will be from 19:25 until 20:35 on 7th July 2023 vehicles will be prohibited from either proceeding along the lengths of road specified below.

- Rolling road closure : The length of road known as Main Street, Whissendine for the distance of 9189 metres. It is anticipated the event will start on 7th July 2023 and the will last for 2 hours  
The rolling road closure route will be via Main Street, Station Road, From Glebe Road To Station Road, Holygate Road, Whissendine Road, Stapleford Road.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the event is taking place.
