This summary includes all those areas where statistical reporting was appropriate. Where questions generated free-text the views expressed varied widely across all respondents and grouping answers could distort the information.

This report is based on the 123 questionnaires completed. There are 518 households in the village and each was provided with a questionnaire. The response rate was therefore c24%. Those who responded were from all ages: under 18 years to over 80 years. Those who responded were resident in Whissendine and they came from addresses right across the village.

All findings from the questionnaire will be used by Whissendine Neighbourhood Planning Steering Group in developing a Neighbourhood Plan for Whissendine. When the group has a presentable draft plan village residents will be able to comment on it.
